

LABOUR STATUS

Labour force status is used to describe the currently active and inactive population and to produce measures of employment and unemployment based on current economic activity. Since the intention is to determine if a person is employed or unemployed at a specific moment in time, this is normally determined over a specific (short) reference period such as one week.
